



Background & Challenges


- Until 2015, one person was conscripted to coordinate data collection; very little analysis was applied to the data set
- Statistics & Assessment Committee established in 2015; we set out to modernize metrics, conduct retroactive analysis, and develop a standard and more robust reporting procedure going forward
- Challenges: missing, messy, and inaccurate data; slight changes to metrics and definitions over the years; lack of documentation; no data management plan (resulting in loss of raw data); difficulty of comparing disparate institutions


Tools


- Data are collected using a combination of an Excel workbook and a Google form
- "Case Study" and "Institutional Fact Sheets" (left, centre) were created in Tableau Desktop and are best viewed in Tableau (Reader, Public, Desktop) or online.
- Longitudinal analyses by institution type (below) were created in Excel for image clarity

Institution Type	Programs offered	Research
Comprehensive Academic & Research	Comprehensive baccalaureate & graduate programs	Comprehensive research function
Baccalaureate & Applied Studies	Baccalaureate & applied degrees in specified areas, certificates, diplomas	Applied research and scholarly activity
Polytechnical	Apprenticeship, certificate, & diploma programs for technical vocations, some applied & baccalaureate degrees	Applied research and scholarly activity
Comprehensive Community	Certificates & diplomas, adult high school completion, apprenticeship, applied degrees	Applied research and scholarly activity
Independent Academic	Limited baccalaureate programs, may offer limited graduate programming in niche areas	Applied research and scholarly activity
Specialized Arts & Cultural	Certificate, diploma, applied / baccalaureate, and graduate degrees in specified areas	Applied research and scholarly activity









steadily increased at select institution types since 2000 (above). However, library instruction at Comprehensive Community institutions has not kept pace with enrolment increases since 2005, when FLE data collection began (left). A pronounced decrease in library instruction in 2009 warrants further consideration.
