


(a) **Total Expenditures in CARL Libraries / Tabl. V / Dépenses totales des bibliothèques de L'ABRC**





(e) **Selected yearly staffing trends in CARL librairies / Sélection de tendances annuelles du personnel des bibliothèques de L'ABRC**




Figure 1 CARL 7 year Selected Staffing Trends (%) / Sélection de tendances du personnel de L'ABRC sur 7 ans (%)

(f) **Enrolment trends in CARL librairies (FTE) / Tendances des inscriptions dans les bibliothèques de L'ABRC (ETP)**




Figure 2 CARL 6 year Total Enrolment trends (FTE) / Tendances des inscriptions totales de L'ABRC sur 6 ans (ETP)
